The company is also involved in a range of consortia including EUROMIDS (FR, IT, GE, UK) for the supply of MIDS Link 16 terminal for various platforms and Eurofighter (IT, GE, UK, SP). In addition, it is engaged in many important programmes such as JSF, for the supply of radios, cockpit panels and lights; NATO-AWACS for the supply of UHF radios, sitcom and IFF; NH 90, EH 101, Tornado, C27J and C130J. In the United States of America, SELEX Communications and Lockheed Martin have entered into a collaborative agreement to share marketing information and jointly evaluate potential U.S. governmental and civilian opportunities using the SELEX Communications Laser Obstacle Avoidance and Monitoring (LOAM) system.

SELEX Communications solutions feature in many naval programmes, such as the new generation of Aircraft Carrier/Amphibious ship Cavour for the Italian Navy and the new European Frigates Multi Mission FREMM” for the Italian and French Navy that is expected to supply three different operational ships: general purpose, anti-submarine warfare and landing.

In St. Petersburg, SELEX Communications recently inaugurated a testing and validation centre for the TETRA standard joint venture ZAO “ARTETRA”, with a 51% share capital owned by SELEX Communications and 49% owned by TETRASVYAZ.
